### Introduction

The RA Administrators and RA officers are required to guide bank officers applying for digital certificates as also process their applications and forward to IDRBT Certifying Authority. Officers handling various digital signature enabled application rollouts at various Regional / Zonal / Local Head offices need to be familiar with digital signature certificate application process and certificate life cycle. Further uses of various crypto devices including Crypto-tokens and HSMs that are essential for security of keys, are covered in the programme, it being integral part of digital signature certificate life cycle management.

### Objectives

To familiarize the RA Officials and IT Team members posted in various Regional / Zonal / Local Head offices on various aspects of RA Operations, use of digital certificates in bank applications, use of crypto devices in bank applications, etc. Further to sensitize the officials on the legal and technical aspects of use of digital certificates as well as criticality of security aspects when digital certificates are used in bank application environment.
